1 Open Enrollment occurs from Oct. 15 to Dec. 7 of every year.

- If you enroll in a plan during Open Enrollment, it will not begin until January 1.
- In most cases, Open Enrollment is the only time you can pick a new Medicare Part D plan.

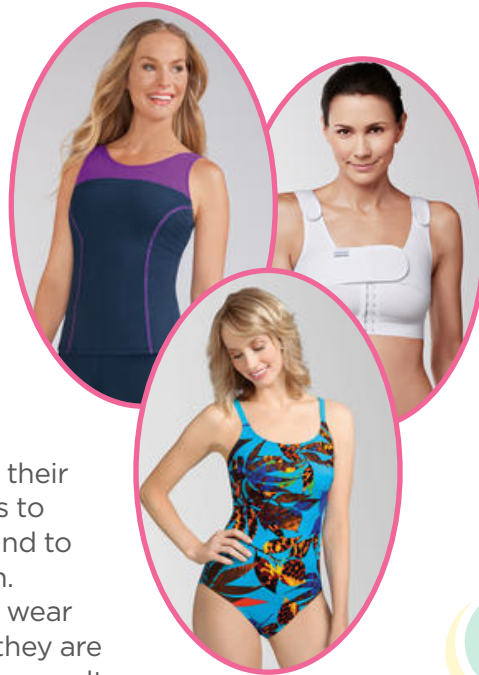
